Shantyman mics Vocal mic SM58 or similar to be provided by the venue.
Dependent upon the venue, a mixture of vocal mics (for the shantymen) and ambient for the rest of the band

Stomp pedal



This DI box requires phantom power Whilst the full compliment of singers is 12, we often sing with less and so the configuration is a dynamic one – the same applies to the number of instruments. The shantyman mics are for the lead soloists who sing the verse – the others join in on the chorus. The stringed instrument players need to be able to see each other for timing purposes. The stringed instrument player on stage right has a "kill switch" for when he changes instruments between guitar, bouzouki and mandolin. The "arc" shape of the band configuration is exaggerated and can be much shallower, plus the bodhrán players and the stomp pedal player sometimes swap sides.

AUDIENCE



Only one guitar playing at any one time at this side of the stage, using a shared DI box
